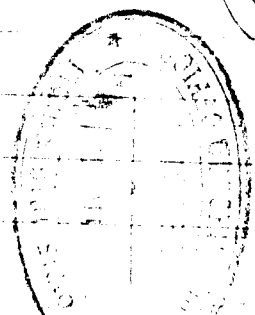
I Dinah Bailey do hereby make my last will and bequeath to my Brother William Bailey of Mountmellick the sum of two Hundred Pounds due by John Wilkinson of Moritt in the Queen County I leave to my Brother-in-law Joseph Morgan the interest of three Hundred Pounds which is at present lent by me to the firm of Bailey son & Gibson at the rate of six percent per annum the above mentioned three Hundred Pounds to be equally divided between my two nephews Ernest Morgan and Joseph Francis Morgan of Mountmellick to my sister-in-law Isabella Luttrell the interest of my house in Henry Street Mountmellick at present occupied by Wm Pitt also the 20 due to me by Thomas Meredith of Ballyduff in the Queen County I will my property in Monasterian equally between my Nieces Caroline Elizabeth Bailey, Rachel Bailey, Jane Bailey & Charlott Bailey as mentioned in the will of my late husband Jonathan Luttrell my piano at Theobroth & my locknet & gold chain to my niece Rachel Bailey at present in Belganey also my two first rings & the late two to my stepdaughter my poney & trap to my stepson William George Bailey This is my last will leaving for America the 27 of March 1899
