I, William Bailey of Hollybank House, Sandford, in the County of Dublin, hereby revoke all wills and testamentary dispositions heretofore made by me and declare this to be my last will I appoint my son-in-law Adam Henry Gibson of Hollybank House and my son William George Bailey the Executors of this my will I direct my said Executors to pay my just debts funeral and testamentary expenses I bequeath my gold watch and chain to my son William George Bailey I bequeath my Iron safe and any money that may be in it at the time of my death to my daughter Mary Jane Gibson the word "money" not to include scrip or any form of property or asset contained in said safe save ready cash I devise and bequeath all the residue of my own property of every nature and description, both real and personal to my son the said William George Bailey and to my daughter the said Mary Jane Gibson equally as tenants in common I desire and direct my said son William George Bailey to pay out of his moiety of the residue the sum of Fifteen pounds (£15) per annum for a period of ten years from the date of my death to my grandson Oliver Smith who at present resides in Philadelphia, United States of America, said terminable annuity to be paid in half yearly instalments the first of such half yearly payments to be made six months after my death and the remaining payments at intervals of six months until the expiration of said ten years I also desire and direct my said daughter Mary Jane Gibson to pay out of her moiety of the residue a like sum of Fifteen Pounds (£15) per annum for a period of ten years from the date of my death to my grandson the said Oliver Smith said terminable annuity to be paid in half yearly instalments the first of such half yearly payments to be made six months after my death and the remaining payments at intervals of six months until



the expiration of said ten years similar to the payments
