**Will of Aloysia Clare (Russell) Wood**

Died intestate and this is her husband Lambert George Wood applying for grant of Probate.  
She died 2<sup>nd</sup> April 1902 (perhaps childbirth see details later) aged 32 therefore DOB 1870

**Will of Lambert George Wood 1903. Died 4<sup>th</sup> Oct 1903**

This is not a Will as such but his mother -in-law Ellen Russell applying for guardianship of his one and only child her Grandson, Percy Russell Wood.

*Extract:*

<<<<<<<<Know all men by these present that we:

*Ellen Russell, 24 Kilmorey St. Newry Co. Down.*

*John Stokes, Dublin Road, agent of the Dundalk -Newry Steam Pk. Company.*

*John Treanor, Hill St. Newry, Draper.*

*Condition of this application is such, that if the above bourden, Ellen Russell, maternal grandmother of Percy Russell Wood, an infant under the age of 7 years and lawful child and only next of kin of Lambert George Wood. File for Ellen Russell by Sheridan and Russell Solicitors, 50 (unlegible) Street, Dublin.>>>>>>>*

On another document it states that Percy Russell Wood is 1 1/2 years old in Nov 1903 which makes me think that his mother may have died due to childbirth.

**Will of Ellen Russell now living in Meath Louth.**

I appoint Hugh McCaffery and John J McAreyve of Newry, Merchants, as executors and guardians of Percy Russell Wood of tender years.

To be brought up in the Roman Catholic religion as hereforeto, and I expressly direct the above mentioned guardians to look after the religion of said Percy Russell Wood and to take all necessary steps to carry out my wishes in this respect. *(get the impression that she was worried that someone would stop this happening)*

**In 1911** Percy Russell Wood is at the Seaview Boarding School in Warrenpoint, Co. Down. He is the nephew of Gertrude Rosabelle Russell who is the head of the family members and the school. He is now aged 9 years. Gertrude is a widow, aged 42 years, a widow, so she must have been married to wee Percy's uncle perhaps?
